Students in 5th-8th grades wanting to participate will need to check in to aftercare and wait to be called out. Once a student is offered a spot on the team, parents are responsible for attending an informational meeting, providing a current physical for their child, and paying an athletic fee.

CHAPERONES FOR FIELD TRIPS

If you would like to be considered as a chaperone for your child's field trip, you must possess a DPS Class 1 IVP Fingerprint Clearance Card. You may apply for one by going to [AZDPS.gov](https://www.azdps.gov). Once you have your card, bring it into the front office so that they may have a copy on file.
